DETAILED INFORMATION

It is intention of Finmeccanica Global Services S.p.A. (hereinafter "**FGS**") – a sole shareholder company subject to direction and coordination of Finmeccanica - a Public Limited Company (S.p.A.) - to issue a call for tender concerning the provision of Mobile Telephony Services across UK sites of the Finmeccanica Group Companies (hereinafter "Companies").

The RfQ starting price is approximately 1.800.000,00 £ (twomillionsandonehundredthousand/00 GBP).

It is agreed and understood that the call for tender is open only to suppliers satisfying the following minimum requirements for participation (hereinafter, the "**Minimum Requirements**") for whom it is requested to provide proper documentation:

- minimum yearly overall net turnover within the last three years period (2012/2014), prior to the publication of this call for tender, of 9.000.000,00£ = (ninemillions/00 GBP) each year;
- execution, within the last three years period (2012/2014), of contracts for services similar to those in scope of the present call for tender with a minimum overall total net value of 5.400.000,00£ = (fivemillionsfoure hundredthousand/00 GBP);
- It is not permitted for any Services reseller or Mobile Virtual Network Operator (MVNO) to join the RfQ.



It is not permitted to join the RfQ by:

- any supplier whose turnover is generated by orders/contracts by one or more Companies of the Finmeccanica Group for more than the 70% of the total, except if expressly authorized by FGS for particular technical requirements;
- any temporary grouping/association of companies or European Economic Interest Grouping (EEIG).

It is furthermore forbidden to join the RfQ by a parent company and its subsidiaries. In case of violation of this prohibition will be excluded from the negotiation procedure both the parent company and its subsidiaries.

By and no later than the call for tender deadline, suppliers satisfying minimum requirements and interested in joining the RfQ are required to:

- register on the FGS Supplier Portal (link: <https://supplier-registration.finmeccanica.com>) and, once receiving access credentials, to complete the data required to achieve the status of "Potential Supplier". For suppliers already registered and in possession of access credentials it is requested to check and possibly update the data entered in the system.
- submit the documentation listed below to gare@pec.finmeccanicaglobalservices.com via certified e-mail (PEC), making reference to the call for tender in the subject of the e-mail:
 - Disclosure of interest using the form duly provided for that purpose Mod REG – 01 02;
 - Ethical-legal self-declaration compiled using the FORM PRO-12 02;
 - Company registration report with valid certification of good standing (in countries where applicable);
 - Brief company presentation with details of major contracts performed over the last 5 years for similar subject and value;
 - Documentation on company headed paper explicitly certifying the compliance with the Minimum Requirements;
 - Copy of the declarations by at least two banks or authorised intermediaries certifying financial and economic capacity/stability.

The abovementioned documents, except for the Disclosure of interest, shall be produced also if the supplier chooses to pre-qualify themselves by uploading documents directly into the Supplier Portal of FGS.

Note that any communications received after the expiration term or sent by non-certified e-mail addresses shall not be taken into consideration.

In any case all the suppliers, which have submitted the Disclosure of interest, acknowledge and accept that they cannot claim any right to be invited to RfQ and there is no obligation for FGS to provide any reasons.

Shall be excluded from the Tender, without giving any justification, any supplier not considered sufficiently reliable, due to having incurred, by way of example but not limited to, over the last three years:

- termination for default of contracts stipulated with FGS itself, Finmeccanica SpA or other Companies of the Finmeccanica Group;
- declared defective test of services or supplies subject of contracts stipulated with FGS itself, Finmeccanica SpA or other Companies of the Finmeccanica Group;
- violation, during execution of previous contracts, of any of the provision contained in the Code of Ethics of FGS itself, Finmeccanica SpA or other Companies of the Finmeccanica Group;
- failure in taking in charge, for default or cause, supplies, works or services assigned by FGS itself, Finmeccanica SpA or other Companies of the Finmeccanica Group;
- revocation of an awarded tender.

Pursuant to art. 28 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, as subsequently amended and supplemented (hereafter "**Privacy Code**"), FGS hereby informs all interested parties to observe the rules of the Privacy Code in the treatment and collection of personal data, acquired in the performance and in dependence of this call for tender , as well as the formalization and management of the contract and for the purposes connected with it. The Data Controller is Finmeccanica Global Service S.p.A., with registered offices in Rome – 00195 , Piazza Monte Grappa, 4. The Data Supervisor is Dr. Patrizia Rudilosso, Human Resources, Organisation and Services BU Manager, domiciled in Rome – 00195, Piazza Monte Grappa, 4. People in charge of processing data are the FGS employees involved in processing the call for tender and the relative disclosure of interests and all the subsequent phases.

Proposal submittal procedure, any further cause of exclusion from the Tender and any other information shall be communicated exclusively to the suppliers, that have properly submitted the disclosure of interest and then passed the verification by FGS of the compliance to the Minimum Requirements for participation, as set forth in the present call for tender.

By submitting the disclosure of interest each supplier acknowledges and agrees that the prior acceptance of the Code of Ethics of FGS and the Anti-Corruption Code of Finmeccanica Group is a essential prerequisite for participation in the tendering procedure and therefore, if then invited to participate to the RfQ, undertakes to respect the provisions therein provided. This call for tender shall not be considered in any way binding for FGS or for any person or entity benefiting from the services, and shall not constitute a commitment and shall not entail any cost to be sustained by FGS or by the beneficiaries of the services by any title and neither can arise any expectation of any kind on the suppliers which have submitted the disclosure of interest.



FGS at its own discretion reserves the right to not award the RfQ, to award only part of the contract, to re-start the RfQ procedure or to amend the present call for tender.

Finally, it should be noted that this tender procedure and the relevant contract shall be subject exclusively to private sector law, and it's excluded the applicability of the Code of Public Sector Contracts (Leg. Dec. n. 163/2006) and the relevant implementing provisions, although express references to specific provisions of the Code of Public Contracts (or implementing provisions) are optionally contained in the call for tender or related documents.
